Week #21: February 7, 2016

This week's daily readings:

Sunday, Mark 8:27-38. How might I deny myself today for the sake of Christ and my neighbor?

Monday, Mark 9:1-8. Picture the Light of the World shining specifically into dark places. Listen for the voice of Jesus. What is he saying to me?

Tuesday, Mark 9:14-29. Pray for someone with an addiction, specifically for healing and release.

Wednesday, Mark 9:30-37. How can I be more welcoming of children and others who are vulnerable?

Thursday, Mark 9:38-41. “Whoever is not against us is for us.” Pray for those we might not naturally think of as allies of the Gospel.

Friday, Mark 9:42-49. Jesus is an effective teacher, and uses hyperbole to make a point. But what shortcoming in my life do I need to get serious about?

Saturday, Mark 10:1-16. Pray for the strengthening of marriages. Pray for children and youth you know of who live under difficult circumstances.

As I listen for God's voice in each of these readings, what is God asking me to do, change or become?
