Week #22: February 14, 2016

This week's daily readings:

Sunday, Mark 10:17-31. Notice that before Jesus asks the rich, young man to do a hard task, he gazes at him and loves him. Picture the love Jesus has for you. What is Jesus asking me to leave behind?

Monday, Mark 10:32-34. The disciples were afraid of what might happen as they headed for Jerusalem. Give up a specific fear to God.

Tuesday, Mark 10:35-40. Pray for those in positions of power.

Wednesday, Mark 10:41-45. Pray for the humility to be a servant today.

Thursday, Mark 10:46-52. “He sprang up and came to Jesus.” Picture yourself coming to Jesus. How does Jesus open your eyes?

Friday, Psalm 34:1-8. Name some times when you have “tasted and seen that the Lord is good.”

Saturday, Jeremiah 31:7-14. As you read this passage, picture those who are on your heart in the various verses. (Who are the blind and lame? Who needs his or her mourning turned into joy?)

As I listen for God's voice in each of these readings, what is God asking me to do, change or become?
