This week's daily readings:

Sunday, Mark 12:28-34. How can I show love to my neighbor who is hard to love? To my neighbor who is different from me?

Monday, Mark 12:38-44. Jesus is impressed as a widow gives out of her poverty. There is a chance this woman had been defrauded by the scribes mentioned earlier. Pray for those who need justice to be done.

Tuesday, Psalm 146. What step in my life can I take to free up more resources for the care of the poor? Pray for those who are “bowed down.”

Wednesday, Ruth 1:1-18. Pray for widows you know. Are there ways you can step alongside to help?

Thursday, Psalm 127. What is it that you may be anxious about that you can turn over to God?

Friday, Philippians 4:4-9. It takes more effort for our brain to retain positive thoughts than negative ones. Spend some moments taking the advice of Paul. Think about that which is just, pure, pleasing, etc.

Saturday, Psalm 42. If you are going through a difficult time, what memory of the faithfulness of God can you recall?
