Week #26: March 13, 2016

This week's daily readings:

Sunday, Mark 14: 1-9. What do you think Jesus means by you will always have the poor with you? What does this have to do with the timing of the action of the woman? Notice that Jesus crosses boundaries by being in the home of a leper. How can I walk cross a boundary for Jesus today?

Monday, Mark 14:10-16. Jesus goes ahead of the disciples to prepare the way. Picture the journey ahead for you, and Jesus preparing your way.

Tuesday, Mark 14:17-25. Picture Christ feeding you today. What task do you need strength for?

Wednesday, Mark 14:26-42. How can I awake today to see Christ?

Thursday, Mark 14: 43-50. When have you felt like you betrayed Christ? Claim God's forgiveness, and walk a new way.

Friday, Mark 14: 51-65. Jesus will come again with the clouds of heaven, but he also comes today. Where have you seen him in your midst today?

Saturday, Mark 14: 66-72. Pray for the strength to testify to Jesus in word or deed when the opportunity arises today.

What is God calling me to do, become, or change today?
