This week's daily readings:

Sunday, Mark 16: 1-8. What is a stone in my life that is blocking the way to new life? Who will help me roll away the stone?

Monday, Matthew 25:31-46. The angel had said, Go meet Jesus in Galilee. We meet Jesus out on the road in our neighbor in need.

Tuesday, Acts 10:34-43. Peter is sent to the Gentile Cornelius, a sign that the good news is meant for all people. Pray for those you know who do not know Christ, and that you will know best how to be the light of Christ in their life.

Wednesday, 1 Corinthians 15:1-11. By the grace of God I am what I am. Realize the history that has brought you to where you are in life. Where do you particularly see the grace of God?

Thursday, Psalm 118:1-2, 14-24. This is the day the Lord has made. I will rejoice and be glad in it! For what can I rejoice today?

Friday, Isaiah 65:17-25. In God's future reign, "they shall not hurt or destroy on all my holy mountain." In the Lord's Prayer, we pray that the kingdom would come on earth. Pray for peace.

Saturday, 2 Corinthians 5:17-20. Picture the new creation in Christ that is in you. How can you be a reconciler today?

What is God calling me to do, become, or change today?
