## *This week's daily readings:*

**Sunday, Acts 3:1-10.** Peter and John really notice this man who cannot walk. Whom is God calling me to really notice today?

**Monday, Acts 4:32-37.** This lifestyle of the early church does not last. By the time of the Pastoral Epistles (1 and 2 Timothy and Titus) the writer is admonishing wealthy Christians to be generous, but not to sell it all. Pray about how our local church could care more for each other financially.

**Tuesday, Acts 6:1-7.** Pray for our church leaders, and for our elections coming up at the annual meeting.

**Wednesday, Acts 7:54-8:1.** Stephen is the first Christian martyr. As he dies, he prays similarly to Jesus from the cross, forgiving his murderers. Is there someone I need to forgive today?

**Thursday, Acts 9: 1-30.** Barnabus was an advocate for Paul to the leaders in Jerusalem. Who needs my advocacy work today?

**Friday, Acts 10:1-16.** God causes Peter to rethink his understanding of the law. How has my spiritual understanding/theology changed in the last ten years? Five years?

**Saturday, Acts 34-48.** Peter has to deal with Gentiles in this encounter. Who are those I struggle to identify with? Pray for them.

What is God calling me to do, become, or change today?
