This week's daily readings:

Sunday, Acts 18: 1-11. In Corinth, Paul decides it is time to stop arguing with the Jewish community about Jesus the Messiah. He moves on to the Gentile community. Is one door closing in your life, and another opening?

Monday, Acts 18: 24-28. Aquila and Priscilla mentored Apollos. Is God calling you to be a mentor in the life of someone?

Tuesday, 1 Corinthians 1:18-31. God chose what is weak in the world to shame the strong. Name a weakness in your life, and envision the power of God shining through that area.

Wednesday, 1 Corinthians 3:1-9. Are you a seed planter in the kingdom? A waterer? Give God thanks for your part, and pray for others as God works through them.

Thursday, 1 Corinthians 6:12-20. “All things are lawful, but I will not be dominated by anything.” How can I better glorify God in my body?

Friday, 1 Corinthians 9:19-27. What would it mean to become more like those I am associating with, so that I might be a better witness for Christ?

Saturday, 1 Corinthians 9:23-33. “I try to please everyone in everything I do.” Is God calling me to be a doormat? What would it look like to live this out?
