Week #38, June 5, 2016

This week's daily readings:

Sunday, Job 14:7-15; 19:23-27. In the middle of his distress, Job makes a claim of faith that he will see God after his life is over. Redeemer also means vindicator. In what way might you seek vindication from God?

Monday, Job 23. Have you known the silence of God? Verse 10:b-“When he has tested me, I shall come out like gold.” Give thanks for something you have learned through the testing in your life.

Tuesday, Job 24:1-12. If someone said to you, Why do the poor suffer; God apparently does not care, what would you say? What can you do for someone struggling this week?

Wednesday, Job 28:20-28. Verse 28- The fear of the Lord is wisdom, and to depart from evil is understanding. Picture yourself or others departing from evil.

Thursday, Job 29:1-25. As you read Job recalling times he was used by God, give thanks for the recent times you have been used by God to expand the kingdom.

Friday, Psalm 16:1-11. Job does not have this reassurance yet! What would it mean to keep the Lord always before me?

Saturday, Psalm 22:1-11. Notice that the psalmist moves back and forth between present suffering and memories of the faithfulness of God. Remember the faithfulness of God.

Sunday, Job 38:1-11. Give thanks for your favorite parts of creation.
