### **Week #18: January 10, 2016**

Read the passage. What shines for you in the text? Why do you think that is? What is God calling you to do, change, or become?

#### ***This week's daily readings:***

***Sunday, Acts 10:34-38:*** Pray for those in every nation who “fear God and do what is right.”

***Monday, Psalm 62: 5-12:*** Compare this psalm with the temptation of Jesus in the wilderness. Pray for the power and steadfast love of God in your temptations.

***Tuesday, Jonah 3:1-5, 10:*** Jesus exhorts his listeners to repent, to turn a different direction. The people of Ninevah turn from their evil ways. In what area do I need to turn back towards God?

***Wednesday, Psalm 111:*** An appropriate response to healing is praise. Think of the people Jesus heals in Mark 1, and in your own experience, as you read this psalm.

***Thursday, James 5:13-18:*** Picture laying hands on someone who is sick and praying for healing. Picture the hands of Jesus covering yours.

***Friday, Psalm 29:*** Use this psalm to prepare yourself to listen for the voice of God in nature today.

***Saturday, Psalm 30:*** The leper Jesus heals at the end of Mark chapter 1 cannot help but tell the story. Like the psalmist, remember where your weeping has turned into joy.
