Questions and Answers

1. Q: Who receives these supplies that I donate?

A: The school supply packets are distributed to children of low-income families and children in foster care throughout Clackamas County. The project serves children from Kindergarten through 12th grade.

2. Q: Who is sponsoring the project?

A: The project is a partnership between Prince of Life Lutheran Church, area churches and Oregon Department of Human Services. .

3. Q: How many children are helped through this project?

A: Last year the program helped about 1400 children with basic school supplies.

4. Q: Is my donation tax deductible?

A: Yes! All cash donations are tax deductible, and receipts will be provided. We also recommend keeping your shopping receipts for supplies for your tax records, as these are tax deductible.

5. Q: How do I know these families are really in need?

A: All referrals come from agency case managers who verify need. Our project also supports the outstanding efforts of foster parents and low-income grandparents raising grandchildren.

6. Q: Can I give the supplies directly to the child?

A: We're sorry but, for obvious reasons, we must carefully protect the privacy of our children.

7. Q: How much of my cash donation goes to administrative costs?

A: Not one penny. All donations go directly to the school supplies for the children. All of the project workers volunteer their time; even the cost of mailing has been donated.

8. Q: What is the cost of the basic supplies?

A: The cost of an average school supplies packet is at least \$50.00. Our volunteers are very careful to seek the best prices on all items, and some businesses have also offered discounts.

9. Q: What is needed?

A: A complete list is available on the enclosed START RIGHT brochure. Our goal is to provide each child with a "starter kit" of his/her "very own."

10. Q: Do you want cash or supplies?

A: Either type of donation is welcome. Please donate in the way that is most comfortable for you. Early cash donations help us buy at the best prices.
